

Surrey Transgender Support: Confidentiality Policy

As a requirement of entry, we ask those attending Surrey Transgender Support Group to abide by the following confidentiality policy:

Attendees should not disclose details of any other person who has participated in the group unless they have the express permission of that person(s) to do so. The disclosure includes any information that may identify an individual and includes any photographs taken or shared at the event.

Attendees must not disclose any personal information shared by an individual (including the organisers) at an event unless they have the express permission of that person(s) to do so. A person may be content for their attendance to be disclosed but not the content of any conversations. Personal information includes information shared in group discussions and individual chats.

The disclosure of information excludes circumstances where there is a legal obligation to do so or for the purposes of protecting life or property. In these instances, the disclosure should only be to the appropriate authorities and only to the degree necessary to fulfil these obligations.

A group organiser (or another person leading the discussion) should remind participants of this guidance before any group discussions.
