

# Surrey Transgender Support: Photography

We welcome photography at our events: however, we recognise that some attendees may not wish to be photographed or may be nervous about how photos may be used.

## Photographs Taken By Attendees

1. Please do not take photographs of others without their consent.
2. If consent is given, please clarify the nature of that consent and how the photographs may be used: for example, personal use, use on social media platform, use in printed material.
3. Photographs taken at our event should not be used for commercial purposes without the prior consent of Surrey Transgender Support and, if appropriate, Therapy Gardens.

## Photographs Taken On Behalf of Surrey Transgender Support

1. We will not take photographs of you without your prior consent. We have two levels of consent:
  - With your consent, we may take your photograph on our equipment for **your** personal use. Normally photographs will be transferred by electronic means and retained by us following our GDPR policy.  
You may use the photos as you wish, excluding commercial purposes without our consent.  
If others are in the photo, please obtain their consent before using the photos.
  - With your consent, we may use the photographs on our social media platforms, website or in printed material or by the photographer on his/her social media platforms, website or printed material.
2. In the event of capturing an image of a person without their consent, for example in the background:
  - the image will be deleted, or
  - the image will be cropped to remove that person, or
  - the image will be edited, for example, blurred, so that the person cannot be identified.
